



AMAZONIAN SACRED SOUNDS

4 Weekly Evening Sessions: June 2018



OVERVIEW

Immerse yourself in four evenings of Amazonian shamanic song and energy work. Balance the harmony of sound with male/female energy.

Find your individual sound and learn an Amazonian Kichwa Taki (shamanic medicine song).

SCHEDULE AND LOCATION

SCHEDULE

These sessions will take place as 4 evenings over 4 weeks, from 19:30 – 21:30.

EVENING 1

Monday 4th June

- A brief history on how traditional sounds are used in shamanism
- Journey within shamanic sound
- Understanding how the rainforest birds and animals communicate with sound
- How to feel/sense sound
- Practise meditation with Taki

EVENING 2

Monday 11th June

- Discussion on how humans and animals use sound to communicate
- Interpretation of feelings of light/heavy energies within sound
- Practise and learn a Taki in Kichwa
- Meditation within shamanic sound energy
- Identify sounds you can hear and practise to separate them

EVENING 3

Monday 18th June

- Meditation with shamanic sound energy
- Goup practice of Kurikindi's Kichwa Taki
- Discussion on how to create a personal Taki
- Energy cleansing with shamanic sound
- Finding your personal sound (practise with a partner)

EVENING 4

Monday 25th June

- Perfecting the Kurikindi Taki
- Question and answer session
- Personal energy cleansing with shamanic sound
- Meditation to send gratitude to the four elements
